Centres have recently been established in slum districts in the tribal areas of Baluchistan, in Lahore slum districts and in the Cholistan Desert (Punjab Province).

Funds are needed to cover the running costs of the Schools and Education Centres (situated in homesteads and community buildings) also training for the teachers who are women from within each community.
